Founded in 1999 by the well-known Houston GLBT organizations, PFLAG-Houston and HATCH, PHYSF is dedicated to raising scholarship funds for Houston-area GLBT youth. To date, PHYSF has granted more than \$1.1 million in scholarships to further our objective of educating future leaders of our diverse community. Donations by individuals, foundations, and corporations allow the foundation to provide scholarships to qualifying students.

From 1999 to 2012, PHYSF has awarded 263 scholarships to a diverse body of scholars. PHYSF scholarships have enabled students from over 70 high schools to attend 60 colleges and universities across the country.
